We, the Chinese (Taiwan) Society of International Law (CSIL) and the Student Society of International Law (SSIL), have the pleasure of inviting all schools to participate in the 2020 Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition Taiwan National Qualifying Rounds which will be held on 12-16 February 2020 at National Chengchi University (NCCU), Taipei City. The purpose of the qualifying rounds is to select one Team to represent Taiwan at the White & Case International Rounds to be held on 12-18 April 2020 in Washington D.C., U.S.A.

The CSIL was founded in 1958 with the purpose of promoting research on international law and cross-straits legal issues, and the SSIL, established in 2012 under the auspices of the CSIL, is an organization of students who are dedicated to the promotion of international law in Taiwan. One of our main missions is to coordinate the Taiwan National Qualifying Rounds of the Jessup Competition. For the 2019-20 season, the National Administrator is Pei-Lun Tsai, Vice Secretary-General of the CSIL and Assistant Professor at National Taiwan Ocean University.

Each school may enter one Team, although a duly authorized officer of the school may petition the Executive Director of ILSA, in writing, to allow multiple Teams from one school. Please fill in the Taiwan National Qualifying Competition Registration Form with the Seal of the Department, scan and email it to jessup.taiwan@gmail.com by the deadline above and then pay the National Registration Fee NTD \$3000 (including a deposit of NTD \$500) on 7 December 2019. All participating schools also need to fill in the Team Registration Online Form and pay the International Registration Fee USD \$450 to ILSA.
